REPORT ON BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE 2024 BUDGET IN THE 3 SENATORIAL DISTRICTS OF BAUCHI STATE. SEPTEMBER, 2023.

- **1.0 INTRODUCTION:** The Budget Public Hearing (BPH) is considered to be an opportunity for the stakeholders at all levels: Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs), Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), Community Based Organizations (CBOs), Faith Based Organizations (FBOs), Traditional Institution and indeed the entire citizens of the State to make their contributions into the State Budget. Budget Public Hearing as a component of the Multi-Year Budgeting framework (MTEF) is also another way of ensuring bottom-top approach to government's initiatives through involving a significant number of the State populace becoming not only aware of the **Policies** Government Programmes but their full involvement and initiation/conception of government developmental projects through citizen's inputs which is making the Budget an all-inclusive and participatory, with wider acceptance, feeling of ownership and support as well as holding government and technocrats accountable to the citizens.
- **2.0 OBJECTIVES:** The Director Planning and Programmes of the Ministry of Budget & Economic Planning highlighted the objectives of organizing the Budget Public Hearing as part of the citizens' engagement and participation in Budgeting process. The key objectives are as follows;
 - To get the input of people at the grassroots before the formulation and consolidation of the Budget as it is going to be demand-driven.
 - > To allow for wider participation and all-inclusiveness of citizens.
 - ➤ To create a sense of ownership and sustainability
 - ➤ It also provides a platform between the Government and the Governed
 - ➤ To provides a mechanism for feedback
 - ➤ To provides an avenue for monitoring and evaluation of Government projects/programs.

3.0 CONDUCT OF BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING IN NORTHERN SENATORIAL DISTRICT HELD ON 05/09/2023 AT AMINU SALEH COLLEGE OF EDUCATION AZARE.

The Budget Public Hearing (BPH) was conducted in the Northern Senatorial District comprising 7 Local Government Areas namely: Katagum, Zaki, Gamawa, Itas-Gadau, Jama'are, Shira and Giade at the Conference Hall, College of Education, Azare with over 150 participants which include; Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), Community Based Organization (CBOs), Faith Based Organizations (FBOs), Traditional Institution, People with Special Needs, etc.

- **3.1 GOOD WILL MESSAGES:** Good will messages were delivered by some relevant stakeholders after an opening prayer at 11:00am amongst;
- **3.1.0 Ministry for Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs:** The Hon. Commissioner of the Ministry was represented by the Director Planning Research & Statistics (DPRS) who assured the organizers of Ministry's support and cooperation throughout the budget process and also pledged to organize a similar one in the Local Government Budgeting System in the state which will open more chances of citizen participation in governance at the grass root level.
- **3.1.1. Katagum LGA:** The Katagum Local Government Council assured its commitment and support in the actualization of good governance through opening a window for citizen involvement and participation in its activities particularly the budget process.
- **3.1.2 Faith Based Organization:** The Religious Leaders (Imams and Pastors) also welcomed the Bauchi State Government's idea of enhancing Budget Public Hearing, and pledged to enlighten their followers on supporting government initiatives through participation.
- **3.1.3 State2State:** A representative of State2State (USAID) Governance/System Strengthening Project operating in the State mentioned that, S2S is always

supportive of the Government more especially and particularly on the enhancement of citizen engagement in budgeting process and procedures. He assured the gathering of their active commitment for the overall aim of good governance that will actualize transparency and accountability in the State.

3.1.4 Traditional Institution: This institution is playing a vital role in the peaceful co-existence and developmental initiatives and sustainability. The District Head of Shira who represented the Emir of Katagum pledged that they will add more efforts in discharging their duties of re-orienting the general public towards supporting Government functions and initiatives.

3.1.5 Open Government Partnership (OGP)

A Senior Director in the Ministry of Budget & Economic Planning (Director Planning & Programmes) mentioned that, the State Governor launched the Open Government Partnership (OGP) which provides as an opportunity for the citizens to participate in the governance process in the state. The OGP has strengthened the Public Hearing by giving citizens an opportunity to make inputs into the Budget. He also highlighted that, the Bauchi State Development Plan is being implemented through the annual budget.

4.0 Introduction of the Community Charter of Demand (CCD) by STATE2STATE:

The State2State project as a partner in the area of Public Financial Management in the State particularly in the area of budget management introduced a robust means of channeling communities demand to the relevant Ministries Departments and Agencies (MDAs). A template called Community Charter of Demand which contains a space for locality, projects and other identification was shared to participants. The essence was to give different localities and citizens time to reach a consensus on their selected/prioritized projects for submission to the relevant MDAs/LGA for consideration and integration into the proposed Budget.

4.1 TECHNICAL SESSIONS.

The 2024 Budget presentation (Power Point) was made by the Director Budget, Ministry of Budget & Economic Planning which centered on the Budget cycle, proposed 2024 Government priorities, Macro economic framework and review of 2023 Budget Performance with emphasis on Capital Projects (completed & ongoing). The Director also provided details on the basis of which the budget is developed i.e Macroeconomic Framework such as the Inflationary trends, Exchange rate (Dollar/Naira), Crude oil production benchmark and crude oil price per barrel. According to him the budget is derived from a well-articulated Medium Term Expenditure Framework which includes the full detail and current analysis of the said macroeconomic framework and its historical background of at least 3 years. The Director's presentation came after an opening remark by the Honorable Commissioner, Ministry of Budget and Economic Planning who was represented by the Permanent Secretary (Ministry of Budget and Economic Planning). The presenter also highlighted some completed and ongoing capital projects contained in the 2023 budget such as the Construction, Renovation and Rehabilitation of Roads, Primary and Secondary Health Facilities to serve as a reference for the participants especially for some of them that were able to attend the 2023 Budget Public Hearing conducted in 2022.

4.2 2024 BUDGET FOCUS: The Director Budget in his presentation also pointed out the main focus of the 2024 Government priorities as follows:

- ✓ Agriculture
- ✓ Youth and Women Empowerment
- ✓ Job Creation and Community Development
- ✓ Poverty Reduction through establishment of small scale industries

Budget Public Hearing was conducted in this Senatorial District at Chartwell Hotel, Misau. It comprised of Misau, Dambam, Ningi, warji, Darazo and Ganjuwa Local Government Areas.
